Mission Statement

The Early Learning Coalition of Seminole’s mission is to be the recognized authority in Seminole County for information regarding high quality School Readiness (SR) and child care services which allow parents to make informed choices when selecting child care providers. This mission is pursued through collaborative partnerships with early education and care professionals and concerned community leaders to:

- enhance the quality of school readiness services in Seminole County;
- promote community awareness of critical factors regarding early learning;
- provide scholarships for eligible low income children to attend child care centers; and
- increase participation in the Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK) program available to all four-year-olds in Seminole County.

Evaluation of Direct Enhancement Services

The ELC of Seminole continues to work in partnership with a number of community agencies and businesses to support children with quality early care and education. Current community partners include Heart of Florida United Way, City of Altamonte Springs, Moss, Krusick & Associates, LLC, Disney, Seminole County Public Schools, Seminole State College, Seminole County Community Assistance Division and Seminole County Community Development Block Grant.

In addition, a database is used to flag all child care provider eligibility documents required to conduct business, such as (but not limited to): license expiration, background screenings and affidavits of good moral character. The Provider Services Department provides monitoring and technical assistance to child care providers for licensing and regulatory compliance during technical assistance visits.</p>

<p>What activities has the coalition implemented to promote inclusive child care?</p>	<p>The ELC of Seminole's Inclusion Specialist conducted the following activities to promote inclusive child care in Seminole County:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Warm Line services promoted by Inclusion Specialist monthly during “Market Day” (held from July to October). Providers may speak one on one with Inclusion Specialist during their visit to the Coalition. • Warm Line flyers posted for families in the resource room/computer lab. • The ASQ-3 developmental screening process explained to school readiness families as part of their eligibility appointment. • Technical assistance and training offered to child care providers regarding the ASQ-3. • ELC uses an access database which stores screening results pulled from Family Access to correlate with EFS enrollment information. This allows ELC to ensure all school readiness children receive ASQ-3 developmental screenings by the provider which they are enrolled. • Attended community based events in order to reach out to families in the community and promote the services offered by the Inclusion Specialist. • Attended owner/director and new provider meeting to address issues, questions, and concerns of the providers with the ASQ-3 and Inclusion. • Attended Addressing Challenging Behaviors Conference, Inclusion Network Retreat and One Goal Summer Conference in order to attain information to better assist the families in which we serve.
<p>Provide a description of the quality activities and services the coalition provided to enhance infant and toddler care.</p>	<p>The ELC of Seminole provides many services to enhance infant and toddler care:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CLASS Infant • Toddler Tools • Each of the providers assessed on the CLASS Infant and Toddler Tools received a summary report along with a quality improvement plan outlining strengths and areas of potential growth • In partnership with Seminole State College, the ELC offered a Professional Development Day and an Early Childhood Conference with an Infant/Toddler Track • Infant/Toddler Track afforded the staff training in American Sign Language, sensory integration, the importance of play, music and movement activities along with effective and engaging storytelling

<p>Please describe other quality activities that increase parental choice, and improve the quality and availability of child care.</p>	<p>The ELC of Seminole has implemented several technological improvements that have increased efficiencies in service delivery to families including:</p> <p>Web-Based Appointment System</p> <p>ELC continues to use Appointments-Plus, a web based appointment scheduling program. The program makes automated appointment reminder calls and has email and text capabilities. The system is also used to make telephone announcements to families when the ELC is enrolling families from the School Readiness waiting list. Management pull data from the reporting features to track appointment metrics which is valuable for enrollment purposes.</p> <p>Waiting List</p> <p>The Coalition aggressively enrolled from the waiting list early in the program year. With increased staffing efficiencies, more appointments were made available for families. The Coalition increased service hours to include appointments for new families only on Fridays from 8AM – 12PM from July through November. Approximately 300 families per month apply for school readiness services. The average time an eligible family waited for an enrollment appointment from their application date was from four to six weeks.</p> <p>Summer Camp Funding</p> <p>Through a partnership with Seminole County Community Assistance, the Early Learning Coalition managed the eligibility and enrollment of the Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) to provide day camp scholarships to school age children in Seminole County. This program has previously been managed entirely by Seminole County for the past several years. The purpose of this funding is to provide a safe environment for youth during the summer months. Additionally, this program may enable youth to avoid at risk taking behavior for a defined period of time. In previous years, the scholarship was paid in full and free to all families. By aligning some of the program elements as established in the school readiness program by reimbursing at current ELC of Seminole rates and requiring a parent fee based on the current sliding fee scale, the program was able to serve more children over the course of the program than in previous years by expanding the program dollars further. A total of 92 children were enrolled in summer camp funding.</p> <p>Community Partner Portal</p> <p>The Early Learning Coalition expanded access with Share File document portal to additional community partners. This secure web portal maintained by the Early Learning Coalition allows referrals and supporting documentation to be submitted and shared between the Early Learning Coalition and community agencies referring School Readiness priority 1 and 2 families including TANF and At Risk funded children. The Early Learning Coalition portal is currently used with the following community partners: Career Source of Central Florida, DCF/Community Based Care of Central Florida, Seminole County Sherriff's Office, Rescue Outreach Mission, SafeHouse of Seminole and Seminole County Community Assistance Program. This has increased efficiencies for both agencies, including the parent in obtaining complete child care authorization forms for eligibility appointments.</p>
